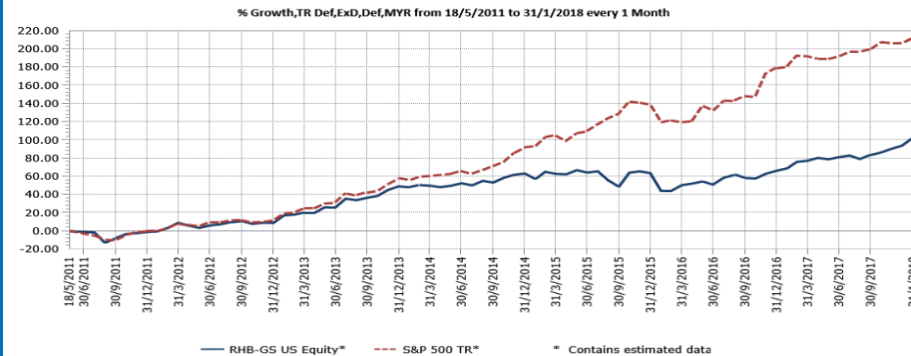

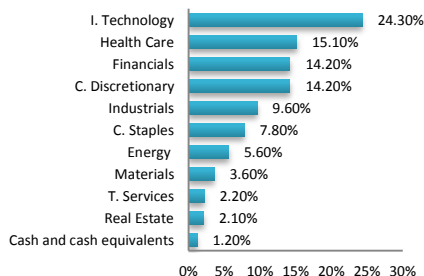

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**MANAGER'S COMMENTS**

**MARKET OVERVIEW**

The S&P 500 index enjoyed a strong start to the year, gaining 5.73% in January (all total returns, in USD) driven by market exuberance over strong economic data, the \$1.5 trillion tax reform plan signed in December and a favorable earning season so far. The labor market continues to highlight tightening slack. While December payrolls data undershot consensus expectations, November data was revised up – the unemployment rate remained unchanged at a 17-year low of 4.1% and average hourly earnings ticked up, rising 0.3% month-over-month (MoM) and 2.5% year-over-year (YoY). In addition, jobless claims fell to 45-year lows mid-month, and remains low despite a subsequent rebound. The fourth quarter earnings season has been robust, with very strong revenue and earnings growth relative to history. Companies are beginning to provide discrete guidance on tax rates, and 2018 earnings forecasts are being upgraded as a result. The January Federal Reserve (Fed) meeting had no change in policy, in line with expectations and with little market impact. Some investors focused on increased confidence in the inflation outlook expressed in the statement. The best performing sectors were Consumer Discretionary, Information Technology and Health Care while the worst performing sectors were Utilities, Real Estate and Telecommunication Services.
