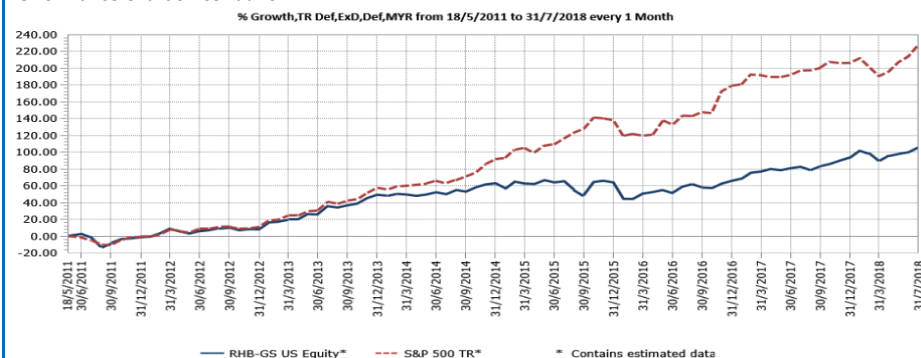

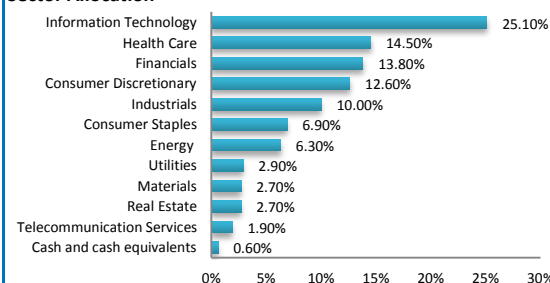

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### MANAGER'S COMMENTS

#### MARKET OVERVIEW

The S&P 500 index gained 3.72% in July, bringing total year-to-date returns to 6.47% (total returns, in USD). Market volatility was high over the month, driven by the trade rhetoric between the US and China as well as other key US allies, and strong US macro relative to other developed and emerging markets. The US economy grew 4.1% year-over-year (YoY) in the second quarter, its fastest annual pace since 2004. July marked the 110th month of expansion, a streak that is one year away from becoming the longest in US history. Core retail sales (excluding autos, gasoline and building materials) and industrial production increased 5% and 3.5% year-over-year (YoY), respectively, in June. US Federal Reserve (Fed) Chair Jerome Powell maintained a narrative of strong growth but high uncertainty around trade policy, particularly on the back of the US announcement to implement a 10% tariff on an additional \$200bn worth of Chinese imports. Prices for products where tariffs apply have risen sharply, with annual washing machine inflation jumping from 2.7% in April to 13% in June. The best performing sectors were Industrials, Health Care and Financials while the worst performing sectors were Real Estate, Energy and Consumer Discretionary.
