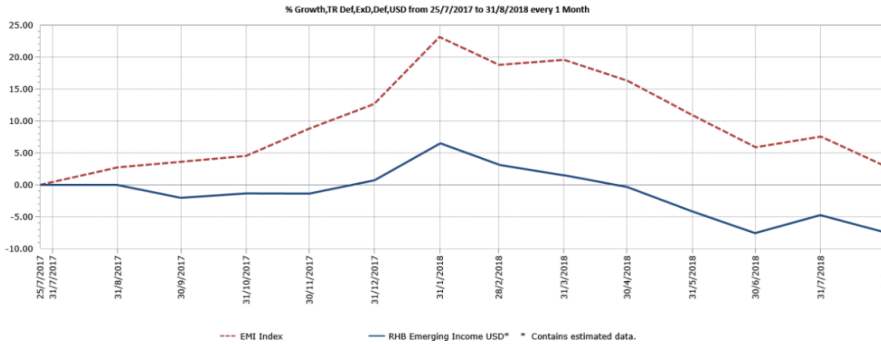

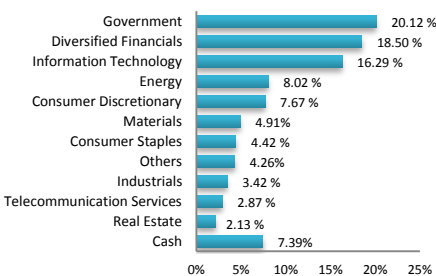

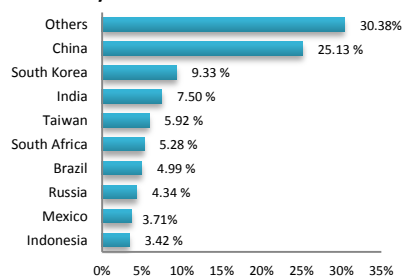

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MANAGER'S COMMENTS**MARKET REVIEW**

Emerging markets fell over the month, as a strong US dollar and protracted US-China trade tensions were compounded by an intensifying currency crisis in Turkey and Argentina. Local currency bonds were firmly down as a result, while other asset classes experienced more modest falls. It is worth highlighting that we do not expect contagion from what remain two highly idiosyncratic situations. In Argentina, text book policies have been suffering from clumsy implementation, while in Turkey, an economically unorthodox approach has been implemented with enthusiasm. The Target Fund's yield at 31 August 2018 was 4.0% p.a.

PORTFOLIO ACTIVITY

Overall the Target Fund remains cautious on local currency debt, credit risk and duration, and retains a tilt towards high quality equities and Asia. Over the month, the Target Fund Manager significantly reduced currency exposure, but maintained equity sensitivity especially in markets that the Target Fund Manager considers increasingly oversold.

MARKET OUTLOOK

Given increasing divergence between countries, the Target Fund Manager thinks it is more important than ever to adopt a precise, focused, granular approach, carefully differentiating between EM assets classes as the cycle matures. Recent market turbulence has created some unusually compelling opportunities across asset classes and the Target Fund Manager will continue to carefully monitor these areas.
