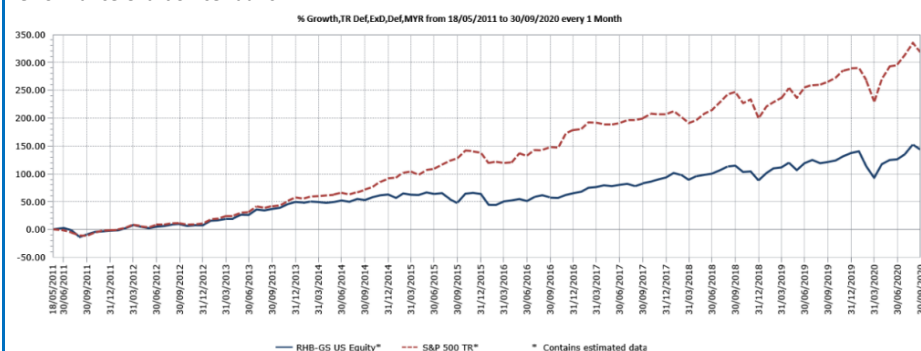

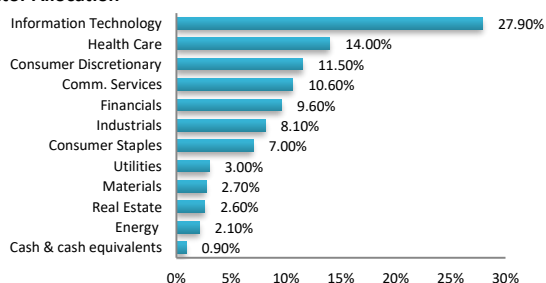

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### MANAGER'S COMMENTS

#### MARKET REVIEW

The S&P 500 increased 8.9% (total returns, USD), and the Russell 2000 returned 4.9% in the third quarter of 2020. The US equity markets continued to rally despite pressure from the pandemic as the S&P 500 has now returned 51.8% (total returns, USD) since year-to-date lows on March 23rd. Market strength has been supported by a sharp cyclical recovery in economic data with ISM Manufacturing PMI increasing to 56.0 in August which is firmly in expansionary territory. Optimism in a potential COVID-19 vaccine also helped support equity markets during the period. The best performing sectors over the quarter were Consumer Discretionary, Materials, and Industrials while the worst performing sectors were Energy, Real Estate, and Financials. Risks to the market continue to persist because of political uncertainty, lower levels of Gross Domestic Product, heightened unemployment, questions around how quickly and effectively a vaccine can be distributed, and debates about the extent of a new stimulus package from the federal government. Although the S&P 500 is now positive on the year, the unclear recovery timeline proves market-timing to be a futile exercise; the Target Fund Manager recommends those with a long investment horizon stay invested. The Target Fund Manager believes this market dynamic favors a rigorous, bottom-up, fundamental approach to security selection, which they think mirrors their investment style. The Target Fund Manager continues to emphasize businesses with healthy balance sheets, stable free cash flow generation, and differentiated business models aligned to secular advantages.

Significant monetary and fiscal stimulus in response to the coronavirus pandemic drove markets higher during the quarter. Economic momentum remained elevated as the unemployment rate fell for a fourth straight month in August to 8.4% and the housing market recovery continued. Expectations for a near-term vaccine breakthrough remained supportive as a number of vaccine candidates entered late-stage trials and the Food and Drug Administration discussed granting emergency use authorization as early as November. However, stalled negotiations for a fifth coronavirus relief bill along with uncertainty surrounding November's presidential election acted as headwinds. As the trajectory of the coronavirus and the election remain unclear, the Target Fund Manager believes that it is crucial to stay true their quality-first investment approach.
