





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MANAGER'S COMMENTS

MONTH IN REVIEW

Global equity markets sold off in October and market volatility rose amid widespread renewed mobility restrictions across Europe and uncertainty about the US election. The MSCI World Index fell 3.12% and the JPM GBI Index was down 0.30% (hedged to euro).

An aggressive second wave of the virus in Europe fuelled investor concerns as all major economies reported new highs in infections rates. Many governments initially imposed targeted local measures of containment, but soon progressed to national level restrictions that will likely weigh on activity in the region. In the US, virus infection rates also rose, but investors were more focused on uncertainty about the US election. Against this backdrop and despite a good third-quarter earnings season, equity markets fell. The Target Fund Manager's long equity exposure detracted from performance, particularly names geared towards virus recovery across consumer discretionary, industrials and technology detracted, while their short-bias equity strategies held for portfolio protection added value.

With market volatility moving higher, the Target Fund Manager modestly reduced risk. The Target Fund Manager trimmed positions and took partial profit on some of the Target Fund Manager's favoured names in technology and utilities that had performed well in recent months. In order to make the portfolio more robust to the varying potential US election outcomes, the Target Fund Manager added long US and emerging market equity put options to provide protection in the event of a negative scenario.

LOOKING AHEAD

The US election race was much closer than had been widely anticipated. With a divided government under Biden, the Target Fund Manager expects a less pro-cyclical environment with lower yields going forward, and the onus falling on monetary policy to take up more of the economic slack. With this outlook, healthcare looks increasingly attractive, supported by a reduced threat of legislation and the Target Fund Manager added to their exposure. Meanwhile, the US dollar is less well supported so the Target Fund Manager added short exposure versus long Japanese yen, Australian dollar and Korean won.

The Target Fund Manager remains flexible to adjust positioning as the outlook evolves with ongoing concerns about virus escalation in the Northern hemisphere into the winter months and Brexit, while they continue to closely monitor vaccine developments, which have the potential to significantly shift the outlook.
