

### RHB-OSK SMART TREASURE FUND (formerly known as OSK-UOB SMART TREASURE FUND)

This Fund aims to achieve long term capital appreciation through investments in a portfolio comprising subscriptions for Initial Public Offerings ("IPO"), low priced securities, medium priced securities and the top 50 listed stocks of the BMSB (in terms of market capitalization) that amongst other things, offer high growth potential.

#### INVESTMENT STRATEGY

- 0% - 10% of NAV: Investments in subscriptions for Initial Public Offerings ("IPO").
- 20% - 60% of NAV: Investments in low priced securities (less than RM2.00).
- 15% - 50% of NAV: Investments in medium priced securities (RM2.00 to RM5.00).
- 15% - 40% of NAV: Investments in the top 50 stocks of Bursa Malaysia (in terms of market capitalisation).
- 2% - 30% of NAV: Investments in fixed income securities, money market instruments, cash and deposits with financial institutions.

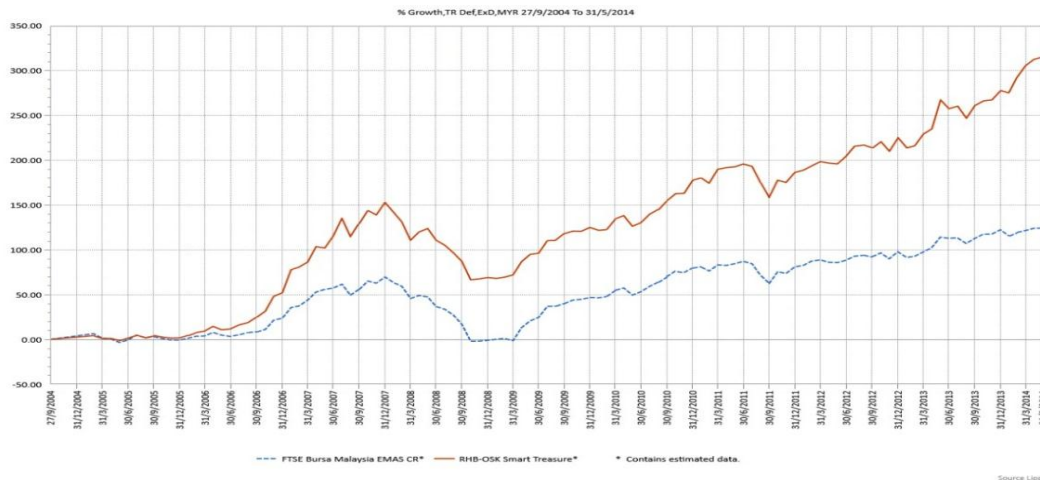

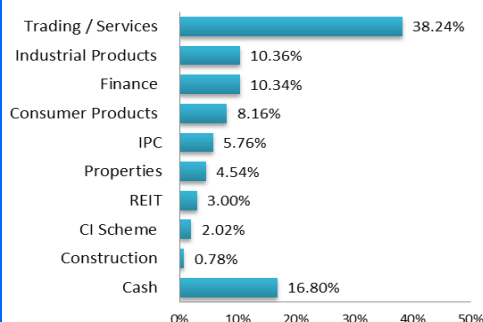

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**MANAGER’S COMMENTS**

**WHY SMART TREASURE?**

- Comprehensive exposure to market from small to large caps
- Large caps can provide relative stability and steadier growth while small caps can offer higher growth opportunities
- Flexibility to shift between equities and cash/fixed income (up to 30%)

**MARKET REVIEW**

For the month, the FBM KLCI rose 0.1% to close at 1,873 points. The broader market underperformed as the FBM EMAS rose marginally to close at 12,946 points. Smaller caps outperformed slightly as the FBM Small Cap rose 0.2% to 17,452 points. Among regional bourses, India and Hong Kong posted the biggest gains while the Vietnam and Philippines were laggards.

On the local corporate front, KLIA2 was officially opened for operations on 2 May. IJM Corp Berhad proposed to acquire Sistem Lingkaran-Lebuhraya Kajang Sdn Bhd for RM398m. JT International Holding BV increased its offer price for the remaining shares of JT International Berhad from RM7.80 to RM 8.20 per share. Meanwhile, 7-Eleven Malaysia Holdings Berhad made its debut at RM1.45, 5% above its IPO price of RM1.38.

**FUND REVIEW**

Smart Treasure’s NAV posted a gain of 0.7%, outperforming its benchmark (FBM Emas Index) which was flattish. The outperformance was mainly due to stock selection. The fund’s top performing holdings were GD Express, Time dotCom, and Public Bank while laggards were Brahims, Kumpulan Fima, and Kian Joo.

- Stock picking in Malaysia to drive outperformance
